ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Cheryl M. Jorgensen is an inclusive education consultant after being a project director with the Institute on Disability at the University of New Hampshire. She was the director of research, personnel preparation, model demonstration, and in-service training grants totaling over \$12 million. Dr. Jorgensen was a founder of the National Center on Inclusive Education, UNH's Teacher Certification Program in Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities, and the Graduate Certificate in Autism Spectrum Disorders.

Dr. Jorgensen has worked with public school teachers, parents, and administrators to increase their commitment to and capacity for including students with developmental disabilities in general education classrooms and to restructure schools to welcome all students. She is the co-author of several books on inclusion—*High Expectations: Beyond Access Model* and *Facilitator's Inclusion Guide*.

In 2008, Dr. Jorgensen received an award from the National Down Syndrome Congress for her contributions to inclusive education research.
